The ceramics tradition, which began over 700 years ago, has made Manises known internationally. Standing out over its long history are: the decorations from the fourteenth to the sixteenth century in cobalt blue, green and manganese, and blue and gilt lustre, Baroque polychrome from the eighteenth century; and the colouring of the tube lined tiles and ceramics of the Modernist period from the beginning of the twentieth century.

In Manises, you can visit craft workshops and shops specializing in traditional and contemporary ceramics where you can buy or order your own pieces. You can even enjoy the incredible experience of being a craftsperson for one day.

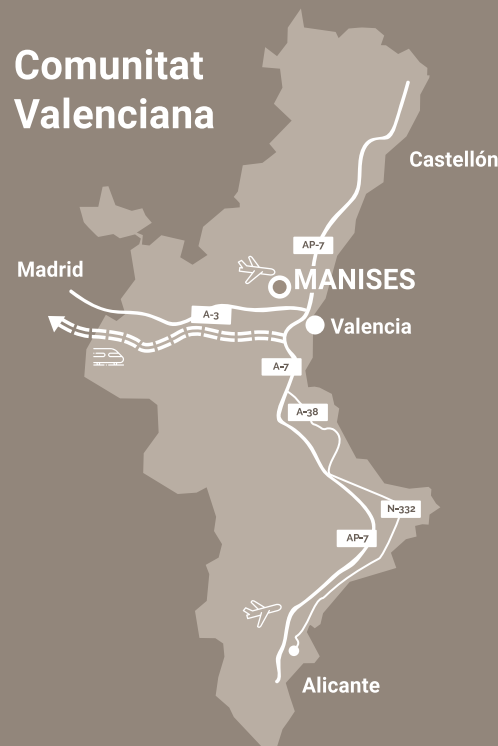

The current facilities, opened in 1990, provide a historical overview of ceramic production in Manises from the fourteenth to the twentieth centuries. It has a technology room displaying the instruments and tools used to make ceramics, and a ceramics art room with a synthesis of the MCM's collection related to international contemporary ceramics.
